Enclosed is a 2009 application for your use. Please note that the membership fee for 2009 will be \$40.00, payable no later than March 31, 2009. The fee after March 31st will be \$75.00. This entitles you to use the computerized handicap system. Non-members will not be able to pay a user fee to access the computerized handicap system. There will be a fee of \$10.00 for each fun tournament in which you wish to participate. This fee will cover the cost of prizes, snacks, refreshments, and the social/cookout following each tournament. Cart fees and green fees are not included in the entry fee. Members are entitled to bring a guest to two fun tournaments, but the guest must have a USGA handicap. Additional play will require the guest to become an association member. We will also be asking for assistance with food preparation for each of the fun tournaments, so please consider volunteering.

A detailed tournament schedule will be completed and made available at a later date and will be mailed to you or left in the pro shop. In the meantime, below is a summary of scheduled events for your planning purposes.
